Phlebotomy Training Program

A phlebotomist is a vital member of the healthcare team. Phlebotomy technicians perform an essential role in collecting, processing and/or transporting blood specimens and other body fluids to the clinical laboratory. They work in hospitals, clinics, doctor offices, private and core laboratories. In today's healthcare environment, the phlebotomists' role is expanding. Baker College of Owosso offers a training program designed to provide the needed skills and knowledge to pursue a career as an entry level phlebotomist in a healthcare setting and take a national certification exam.

The 10 week intensive program provides a total of 75 hours of classroom lecture and lab, along with 100 hours of clinical experience. Classes run Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9 a.m. until 3 p.m. beginning on September 12 and ending on October 14, 2016 with clinical experience immediately following. The Healthcare Provider BLS and FA training will be held on Friday, September 30 from 9 a.m. until 5:30 p.m. Current certification is required.

Candidates need to be health career oriented with an aptitude to work with the ill, injured, young, elderly and/or disabled. The job may be physically demanding and require bending. Course prerequisites include a diploma or GED, a criminal background check and required immunizations.

Cost of the program is \$1,350.00 plus required scrubs and books. If needed, the cost of BLS & FA training is an additional \$75.00.
