Students will not be called out of class for telephone messages unless there is an emergency. Emergency messages will be taken to the student’s scheduled classroom.

The lost and found is located in the College Facilities Office. The College cannot be responsible for articles either lost or stolen. We ask that you take special care of clothing, textbooks, etc. We suggest that items of great value be carried with you at all times.

In the interest of public health and cleanliness, food and beverages are allowed only in the Student Lounge.
