

Health Screening Directions

Nothing is more important than the health and safety of our employees, students, visitors, and communities. Our goal is to work together to stop the spread of COVID-19 and maintain a healthy campus community.

To achieve this, all employees, students, and visitors entering a Baker College location are required to complete a self-certification health screening prior to coming to campus daily attesting that they are asymptomatic of COVID-19 indicators. Only if unable to complete prior to coming to the campus, a station and/or paper form will be available at the designated entry.

These questions are intended to validate that you are asymptomatic and can safely come to campus.

Assess each question and determine if you will respond with an overall “Yes” or “No” response.

The two key questions asked are:

- 1.** Excluding a chronic condition, have you had any of the following symptoms in the last 14 days: cough, shortness of breath, fever (100.4 or above), new loss of taste or smell, diarrhea, chills or repeated shaking with chills, or a sore throat?
- 2.** Have you had close contact (excluding a professional capacity, such as a healthcare facility where appropriate PPE protocols are in place) within the last 14 days with someone diagnosed with COVID-19 or who has experienced COVID-19 related symptoms?

Evaluate Survey Questions Based on Your Condition

If you are able to answer **“YES”** to **one or more of the survey questions**, select **“YES”** within the survey, then click **Submit**. If you answer yes to any of the questions, do not report to campus and wait for communication from Human Resources.

If you are able to answer **“NO”** to **all of the survey questions**, select **“NO”** within the survey, then click **Submit**.

Once your response is submitted, you will receive a confirmation message sent directly to your email.
