



## Baker College Undergraduate Student Admissions Requirements

Here are the next steps in the admissions process. Please read items 1-6 carefully and contact the Baker College Enrollment Center with any questions you may have:

### **1). Official High School, GED (or State High School Equivalency Exam), or Home School Transcripts are required for all new Baker College students.**

- a. Official high school, GED, or home school transcripts will be required for all students pursuing a degree at Baker College.
- b. At a minimum unofficial high school, GED, or home school transcripts are required to determine eligibility (see Step 3). Current year high school graduates should request (or in some cases re-request) official transcripts as soon as your graduation date has been posted to your transcript.
- c. Students who have not submitted official high school, GED, or home school transcripts by the end of their first semester of attendance will be withdrawn from future semester courses.

- Home School Transcript:** Home school transcripts are transcripts produced by a parent/legal guardian or home school organization and must be mailed directly to Baker College by the parent or home school organization.

- ACT/SAT Scores:** Students who have taken the ACT Exam, or have taken the ASSET/COMPASS Assessment within the last two years, should request their ACT scores ([www.actstudent.org](http://www.actstudent.org)), or ASSET/COMPASS Assessment scores from the institution where the assessment was completed. SAT scores within the last two years can be requested at:

- AP/CLEP/DANTES Scores:** Students who have completed AP, CLEP, or DANTES (also known as DSST) exams should request to have transcripts sent directly to the address listed above:

## Baker College Undergraduate Student Admissions Requirements (cont.)

**Note: In order for transcripts to be considered official they must be sent through the mail or electronically directly to Baker College from the issuing institution. We are not able to accept transcripts mailed or emailed from students as “official.” Faxed transcripts are not accepted.**

**Students with International high school or college credentials please see International Student Requirements.**

### **2). College Transcript Request:**

- College Transcript Request:** Students are required to request official transcripts from **ALL** colleges previously attended and have them forwarded to:

Electronic transcripts received by Baker College through Parchment, National Student Clearing House, E-Script or other electronic transcripts services are acceptable.

### **3). Fast Track (FSTRK) Information:** Coursework called Fast Track may be required if:

- a.** You have not attended college in the past.
- b.** Your high school GPA or ACT/SAT scores do not indicate readiness for college level math and/or English.
- c.** You have attended but transcripts do not indicate enrollment in college level math and/or English.

Students with high school transcripts less than 5 years of age, or ACT/SAT or GED (2016 or later) scores less than 2 years of age at the time of enrollment, will have math and English readiness determined by high school GPA, or ACT/SAT, or GED scores.

- Fast Track Coursework:** Fast Track courses are online, self-paced learning opportunity designed to help students identify and address learning gaps in the areas of math and English.

Failure to complete Fast Track, or provide Baker College with high school transcripts, previous college transcripts indicating enrollment in college level Math and English and/or assessment scores, could delay your acceptance to the college and registration for courses. Further, it will result in delays in awarding your financial aid.



## **Baker College Undergraduate Student Admissions Requirements (cont.)**

Students whose performance in the Fast Track coursework does not indicate readiness for college-level study in the areas of Math and/or English will need to satisfy college level Math and/or English coursework at another institution or [alternative credit provider](#) prior to being accepted into, and taking courses with, Baker College.

### **4). “MyMajors” Career Assessment:**

- To better understand how we can help you achieve your career goals students are required complete Baker College's MyMajors Assessment. There is no charge to take the assessment, is completed all online, and will take only a few minutes of your time.

The assessment not only produces best fit majors for you but also provides a detailed advisement report which can use to discuss your career goals and interests in more detail.

**Students who have successfully completed Fast Track courses, have satisfied specific program requirements (for example a background check, or program specific waivers), and have successfully completed the Baker College New Student Experience, will be allowed to register for Baker College courses.**
