Overview

Baker College believes that a COVID-19 vaccination is an important and effective component to protect our campus community from COVID-19.

- All BC employees are highly recommended to receive the COVID-19 vaccination and all booster shots that they are eligible to receive.
- All students are highly recommended to receive the COVID-19 vaccination and all booster shots that they are eligible to receive.
- Faculty and students who work in or are enrolled in Nursing, Health Science, or OT/OTA are required to provide proof of vaccination or apply for an exemption if their clinical site requires a COVID-19 vaccination.

This information is subject to change as the pandemic and guidance continue to evolve and will be regularly reviewed as public health guidance dictates.

Scope

This information should be reviewed by all faculty, staff, and students on all BC campus locations. Individuals may wear a mask based on their comfort level.

Vaccine Verification for Nursing, Health Science and OT/OTA

For faculty and students who are attending a clinical site that requires a COVID-19 vaccination, vaccination records can be uploaded via the form below:

• To report that you have received all doses and boosters of a vaccine series, submit information via the COVID-19 Vaccination Completed form.

BC is providing exemptions to the vaccination requirement for medical or religious reasons.

- Medical exemptions. Individuals requesting an exemption due to a medical condition that precludes them from receiving the COVID-19 vaccine may submit a request for a medical exemption. Documentation from a medical provider is required.
- Religious exemptions. Individuals requesting an exemption due to a sincerely held religious belief that precludes them from receiving the COVID-19 vaccine may submit a request for a religious exemption and follow the exemption process.
- Requests will be reviewed by designated BC staff. Individuals seeking an exemption will be informed whether their request is approved or denied via email.

Beyond the BC exemption, students and faculty will also need to apply for an exemption at the healthcare facility where they will be learning or working.
