

Effective June 8, 2022

Research shows that transmission of COVID-19 is greatly reduced, and lives are saved when all individuals wear face coverings while in areas deemed to have high public virus transmission. Vaccination is also an effective tool to reduce the spread of COVID-19. It is the shared responsibility of the entire BC community to protect not only their health but the health of the BC campus community from serious illness and death from COVID-19. This policy is separate and distinct from the BC [COVID-19 Vaccination Policy](#).

In light of increasing case transmission due to COVID-19 variants, BC is again recommending the use of face coverings. Effective June 8, 2022:

- Anyone who wishes to wear a facemask should wear one as they deem it necessary.
