Articulation Agreement Between Baker College and the Wexford Missaukee Career Technical Center





The purpose of this agreement is to facilitate the transition of students from a high school occupational and/or Career and Technical Education (CTE) program to Baker College. The secondary program listed below is offered as part of the Early Middle College Program at the Wexford Missaukee Career Technical Center in Cadillac, Michigan. If students complete the listed required segments with a B- or higher, and complete the proper paperwork for articulation, they are eligible to receive articulated credit for the post-secondary courses listed below. The post-secondary courses can be articulated into the identified post-secondary programs.

General Conditions and Requirements:

- 1. Student must apply for articulated credit at Baker College within one year (12 months) of high school graduation.
- Student must complete the Application for Articulation, attach a high school transcript and send them runningstart@baker.edu
- 3. Student must complete the course (inclusive of the identified segments) with a "B-" average or higher.
